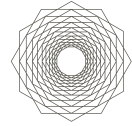


EYEON PRODUCT PROJECT PLANNING & CONTROL BENCHMARK

Session 3: Business Planning

The last session will focus on both your tactical multi-project planning and your strategic planning.

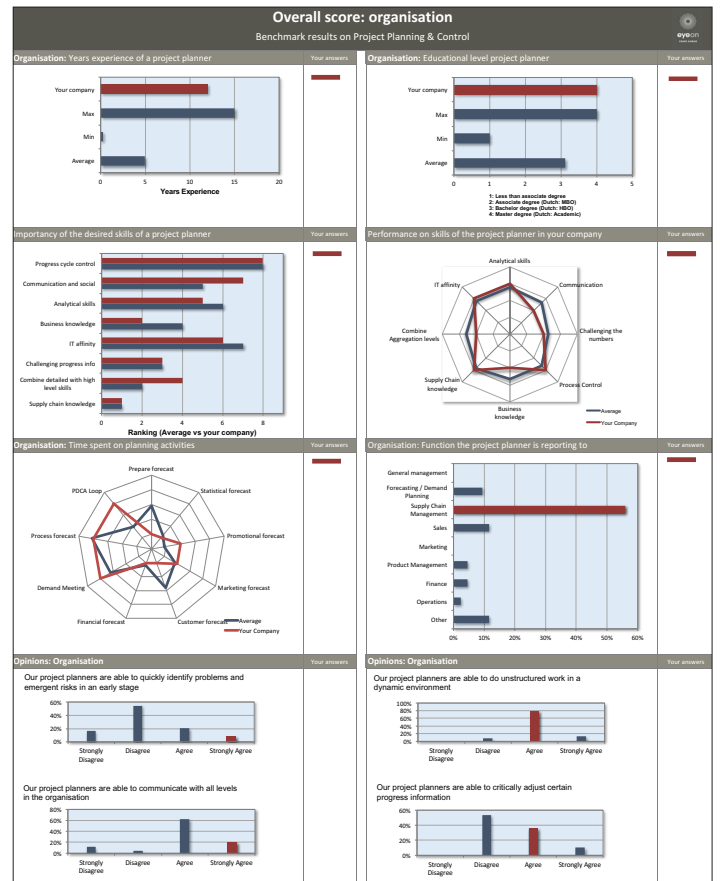
